

PHASE 1 AUTISTIC

Autistic Phase has 6 classes. Each class has an assistant teacher and an educator. The phase accommodates 6- 18 year-olds.

CURRICULUM

2 Classes follow the SID curriculum (Grade R and Grade 1) which comprises of the following subjects:

- English Home Language
- Mathematics
- Life Skills:
 - Personal and Social Well-being
 - Physical Education
 - Creative Arts
 - Performing Arts

4 classes follow Learners' with Severely to Profound Intellectual Disability (LSPID) curriculum which comprises of the following subjects.

- English home Language
- Mathematics
- Life Skills
 - Personal and Social Well-being
 - Creative Arts (Visual art and performing Art)
 - Physical Education

Learners are working according to the following groups that are described according to the level of attainment and participation:

- Awareness
- Transitional
- Interactive

For each of our learners, the educators and parents formulate Individual Education Programme where learners' strengths and areas of needs are identified. Therapists also work with some of our learners. Our learners take part in other school activities e.g concert, fundraising activities etc.

PHASE 3

Grade 4

We all follow the SID curriculum which comprises of the following subjects:

- English Home Language
- Mathematics
- Life Skills:
 - Personal and Social Well-being
 - Natural Science
 - Basic Computer Skills
 - Physical Education
 - Creative Arts
 - Performing Arts

We are divided into the following groups according to age:

Year 1 – 13 – 14 years (SID 10)

Year 2 – 14 – 15 years (SID 11)

Each of our learners, together with their educators and parents chooses 3 of the following Electives in Grade 4 (Phase 3) with which they follow through until they complete their schooling at age 18 years:

- Personal Care: Hairdressing and Beauty Care
- Personal Care: Beauty and Nail Technology
- Consumer Studies: Food Production
- Consumer Studies: Needlework
- Arts and Crafts
- Ancillary Health Care
- Service Technology: Maintenance
- Service Technology: Woodworking and Timber

We have equipped workshops catering for the above Electives.

PHASE 4

Grade 5

We all follow the SID curriculum which comprises of the following subjects:

- English Home Language
- Mathematics
- Life Skills:
 - Personal and Social Well-being
 - Natural Science
 - Basic Computer Skills
 - Physical Education
 - Creative Arts
 - Performing Arts

We are divided into the following groups according to age:

Year 1 – 15 – 16 years (SID 12)

Year 2 – 16 – 17 years (SID 13)

Year 3 – 17 – 18 years (SID 14)

Each of our learners, together with their educators and parents, chooses 3 of the following Electives in Grade 4 (Phase 3) with which they follow through until they complete their schooling at age 18 years:

- Personal Care: Hairdressing and Beauty Care
- Personal Care: Beauty and Nail Technology
- Consumer Studies: Food Production
- Consumer Studies: Needlework
- Arts and Crafts
- Ancillary Health Care
- Service Technology: Maintenance
- Service Technology: Woodworking and Timber

We have equipped workshops catering for the above Electives.

WOW (World of Work) Program:

- **Internal work program: Learners do work in and around the school**
- **External work program: Learners are assigned to outside workplaces to gain experience.**

Grade 5.3: These are our Seniors (School Leavers) and parents of this group of learners are required to pay for their children's School Leaver jackets towards the end of the 1st term which they will be allowed to wear to school, as well as a formal farewell function.
