

PHASE 2

Phase 2 starts educating and equipping learners in the early stages of their development and assists them with the necessary skills to navigate their future academically, physically, socially, culturally and emotionally, with a special emphasis placed on creative and practical skills.

Phase 2 caters for Grade R to Grade 3 learners between the ages of 6 and 12 years and follows the Severe Intellectual Disability (SID) curriculum in the following subjects:

- English Home Language
- Mathematics
- Life Skills:
 - Personal and Social Well-being
 - Natural Science
 - Physical Education
 - Creative Arts
 - Performing Arts

The phase comprises of nine classes and educators, as well as five support staff members. The learners progress, according to their age, through the grades and years as follows:

- Gr R: 5,6,7 yrs (SID 1-3)
- Gr 1 Yr 1: 8 yrs (SID 4)
- Gr 1 Yr 2: 9 yrs (SID 5)
- Gr 2 Yr 1: 10 yrs (SID 6)
- Gr 2 Yr 2: 11 yrs (SID 7)
- Gr 3 Yr 1: 12 yrs (SID 8)
- Gr 3 Yr 2: 13 yrs (SID 9)
